"When evening came, His disciples went down to the lake, ¹⁷where they got into a boat and set off across the lake for Capernaum. By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. ¹⁸A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. ¹⁹When they had rowed three or three and a half miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were terrified. ²⁰But He said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid." ²¹Then they were willing to take Him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading. ²²The next day the crowd that had stayed on the opposite shore of the lake realized that only one boat had been there, and that Jesus had not entered it with His disciples, but that they had gone away alone. ²³Then some boats from Tiberias landed near the place where the people had eaten the bread after the Lord had given thanks. ²⁴Once the crowd realized that neither Jesus nor His disciples were there, they got into the boats and went to Capernaum in search of Jesus. ²⁵When they found Him on the other side of the lake, they asked Him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" ²⁶Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, you are looking for me, not because you saw miraculous signs but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. ²⁷Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On Him God the Father has placed His seal of approval." ²⁸Then they asked Him, "What must we do to do the works God requires?" ²⁹Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one He has sent."

The Disciples

They were obedient and entered a boat to cross the lake even though it was dark.

"Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of Him to the other side, while He dismissed the crowd. ²³ After He had dismissed them, He went up on a mountainside by Himself to pray. When evening came, He was there alone..."

- Matthew 14:22,23

They were caught in a mighty storm and all of their skills could not save them.

"He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night He went out to them, walking on the lake." - Mark 6:48

• Remember that some of these men (four to seven of them) were fishermen by trade.

They saw a human form walking on the water, and although they were fisherman, this was something that they had not seen before. They were terrified.

"During the fourth watch of the night Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. ²⁶When the disciples saw Him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear."

They allow Jesus into the boat and were immediately saved from the storm.

"Then they were willing to take Him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading." - John 6:21

Jesus

He left the crowds and the disciples and spent time with His Father.

He saw the disciples when they were in need and went to them.

"He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them..." - Mark 6:48

He declares Himself the Son of Man who could give eternal life.

"Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On Him God the Father has placed His seal of approval." - John 6:27

"In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into His presence."

- Daniel 7:13

He said that the Father had given Him the "seal of approval" and that everyone must believe in Him to have eternal life.

The Crowd

They asked the wrong question.

They have the wrong motives.

They wanted to satisfy the wrong need.

"Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On Him God the Father has placed His seal of approval." - John 6:2

They wanted to please God with the wrong action.

"Then they asked Him, "What must we do to do the works God requires?" - John 6:28
